NOTTINGHAM FOREST FOOTBALL CLUB Nottingham

A new training facility was constructed on the existing Nottingham Forest Training Ground, with an attempt to reduce the impact on the operation and use of the overall facility. The client required a low-energy, flexible facility to support the diverse use of the football club.

The upgraded facility comprises a new two-storey training facility. The ground floor consists of the players' dining area and lounge, a full kitchen, a media/conference room, and changing facilities which incorporate thermal showers, hydrotreatment and ice baths.

On the first floor, a cardiovascular gym complete with exercise equipment, a free weights area, physiotherapy treatment rooms and ancillary office accommodation are provided.

We were engaged from the initial inception to develop the infrastructure and M&E design, as well as the energy services strategy. This culminated in the production of the performance-based tender pack. After this, we were retained to undertake the construction phase, project monitoring services, project closeout and post-occupancy sign-off.
