



STICKYARD, CHATSWORTH HOUSE Derbyshire

The old Stickyard is located at the rear of Chatsworth House stables. The building was used as a storage yard and gardener's cottage over the years.

The scheme comprised helping develop an indoor and outdoor educational facility for local schools, which consisted of the renovation of the old cottage and the original covered shelter, together with the addition of new external planting spaces and composting toilets.

It was essential that the original construction was retained and brought back to life with a sustainable engineering solution, which would minimise energy consumption and maximise energy efficiency. All of the power required for the facility is now delivered from the new CHP and wood degasifier system.

We were hired to support the development of the sustainability, energy and M&E services strategies associated with the project, and were therefore part of the process from construction through to completion.
